# LANGUAGE (ESL CLASSES)

Over 30 different people groups and more than 500 individuals have already been a part of English as a Second Language Classes (ESL) at Lakota Hills Baptist church in 2018. Every Wednesday night members of the church prepare and host a meal for a huge group of people from the community. Pastor Travis Smalley says, "God has blessed us so much. We will have between 120 and 180 people from all kinds of different nationalities here weekly." During the meal, the participants have the chance to engage in casual, every-day conversations – in English! This helps build language skills, but also helps develop true bonds between the church and community.

Of course, the ministry doesn't stop there. Classrom style instruction is provided covering numerous aspects of English language and culture. Plus, the evening wouldn't be complete without the 'Team Kid' activities in the Sanctuary: games, stories, missions education, and crafts. Just like Children's Minister Scott Clark says, "The great thing about it is that we get to talk to them about Jesus!"

# FIRST STEP (OHIO CHANGERS)

Matt Stickel went on his first 'changers' mission trip 24 years ago. That initial service project experience opened the door to many more good things – including incredible ways to show compassion and demonstrate Jesus' love. Between 'World Changers,' 'Kentucky Changers," and now 'Ohio Changers' Matt has now been a part of 28 'changers' service projects where lives have been changed.

The skills and experience he has gained have been put to use on the international mission field as well. Whether serving close to home, or on one of the 15+ international trips he has taken, Matt says, "All of them bear a resemblance to this: serving people. Putting yourself second, or last, and serving someone else."

"This is an entry-level mission trip for the youth. God uses it as a stair step," he says. "Everyone that's involved in this mission work gets changed – from the homeowner that we're serving to the servant. It'll change you in an unbelievable way – in a positive way."

## LEGACY (SENECA LAKE)



There is no doubt that Fred has seen a lot of growth over the years in kids who are being fed by God at Seneca Lake Baptist Assembly.
